

Top Industry Consultants Getting The Right Results

Doug Raymond and the NAA were the first to respond to a threat from the National Weight & Measures (NWM) organization to attempt to change the declaration of weight. In July of 2014 the conference of the National Weights and Measures (WMM) voted to clarify that Bag on Value (BOV) technology needs to declare its contents by weight the same as traditional aerosol. The rule becomes effective 1/1/2015, however the rule allows a delay until 1/1/2015 for all BOV containers to be in compliance.
